This term, Room 12 have been working towards a number of National 1 and 2 units in their learning.

We have been learning Spanish and have enjoyed learning Spanish greetings, numbers and colours. We reinforce our learning with lots of fun games including bingo and dominoes. Next, we are going to learn how to name the weather in Spanish.

In numeracy, we have been focusing on life skills maths – this includes measuring, money and time. We have used non-standard and standard units to measure items in the classroom and have used weighing for our cookery lessons. This has also led to a unit in using electrical appliances and we had had the opportunity to use the cooker, microwave and toaster. Next we have the washing machine and dishwasher!

We have also sorted objects and been out collecting data in the environment – car colours etc.

Some pupils from Room 11 attend horse riding through the RDA. They are learning all about horse management – the poop scooping wasn't their favourite job!

In science, we are carrying out investigations and developing how to measure and draw conclusions.
